## GATHERING DATA THAT CONNECTS TRANSIT TO EMPLOYMENT




Missing work and wages is a big topic for the Alameda County Health Department. Nearly one-third (31%) of their surveyed riders said work was the destination most affected by bus service cuts that happened in the County. This employment data is often reflected in cities across the U.S. who have either disinvested or invested in their local public transportation services.

## **TOGETHER FOR BROTHERS HIA SURVEY RESULTS SHOWED**


Data shows young men of color are at the highest risks of unemployment or underemployment. A core barrier for young men of color to find and keep jobs lack of reliable transportation. This includes to and from work from school, home, prayer and other places. If you had a free youth bus pass, would you feel like it would be easier to find and/or keep a job?

## HEALTH OUTCOMES FROM ACCESS TO EMPLOYMENT

Research shows the following changes in health outcomes occur when young people (and all people) get and keep their employment which can be supported from guaranteed access to transportation through policies such as a Universal Youth Bus Pass.

△ Psychological Health- Efficacy - Competency - Critical Thinking - Sense of Worth - Problem Solving- Broader Horizon.
